

SSuite PCDrop Copy Master - User's Guide

To Install the Android Application:

1. Download the [PCDrop APK](#) file on your Android smartphone from MajorGeeks.
2. Open the file manager on your smartphone.
3. Go to the "Downloads" folder.
4. Press on the APK file listed in your "Downloads" folder.
5. Follow the prompts your phone will display to install the file.
6. Your smartphone should now install the file automatically.

To install the Windows Application:

1. Download the [Zip file](#) from Majorgeeks on your Windows desktop computer.
2. Unzip and copy the contents of the zip file to a folder of your choice.
3. Right-click on any of the two PCDrop executables and select "Create shortcut" from the popup menu.

Windows Desktop PC:



On your Windows desktop PC, double click on the shortcut to open the Windows side application.

Android Smartphone:

On your smartphone, open your Android side application, you may find it listed under your apps folder.

Operation:

To select a file to on your Android phone to send to your Windows PC, press on the "+" on the right-hand side of the window to list all the files inside your "Documents" folder. For your Windows PC, the files listed will be from your "Public Documents" folder.



...To send an image to your Windows PC, go to the Image Gallery folder where all your images will be listed, select and copy your selected image of these files to your "Documents" folder, where they will get listed inside the application. On your Windows PC, copy and paste the files you wish to send to your "Public Documents" folder. This is also where the files will be received from your phone.

When you have selected the files, press on the "Add" button. Your image files will now be listed on the main window.

If you don't know your smartphone's IP address, simply send a file, any small file, from your smartphone to your Windows PC running the Windows edition of PCDrop. The sent file will enable to show your smartphone's IP address in the sender's IP address editbox of the Windows edition of PCDrop.

When running the Windows edition of PCDrop, the program will automatically show your Windows PC's IP address on the top center of the program's window. Send your file to that address for a quick reminder what your smartphone's IP address is.

Enter your Windows PC's IP address in the center edit box and press on the "Send" button to send the listed files to your PC. The same actions are taken when you send files from your Windows PC to your Android phone. The interfaces and operation of both applications are exactly the same.
